**Tuesday, March 4th 2008 - Visit to the Dunlap Observatory
Meet at 6:45 pm in the Parking Lot at the Observatory**

The 433rd Cubs will be visiting the David Dunlap Observatory for a tour of the largest telescope in Canada and outdoor star gazing led by an astronomer (weather permitting) or an indoor demonstration and lecture in the administration building.

While this is primarily a Cub excursion, guests including such as siblings with parents are welcome.

Please ensure everyone attending is dressed warmly as the telescope building is not heated!

Note: This may be the last opportunity to see this facility as the University of Toronto intends to sell off the land.

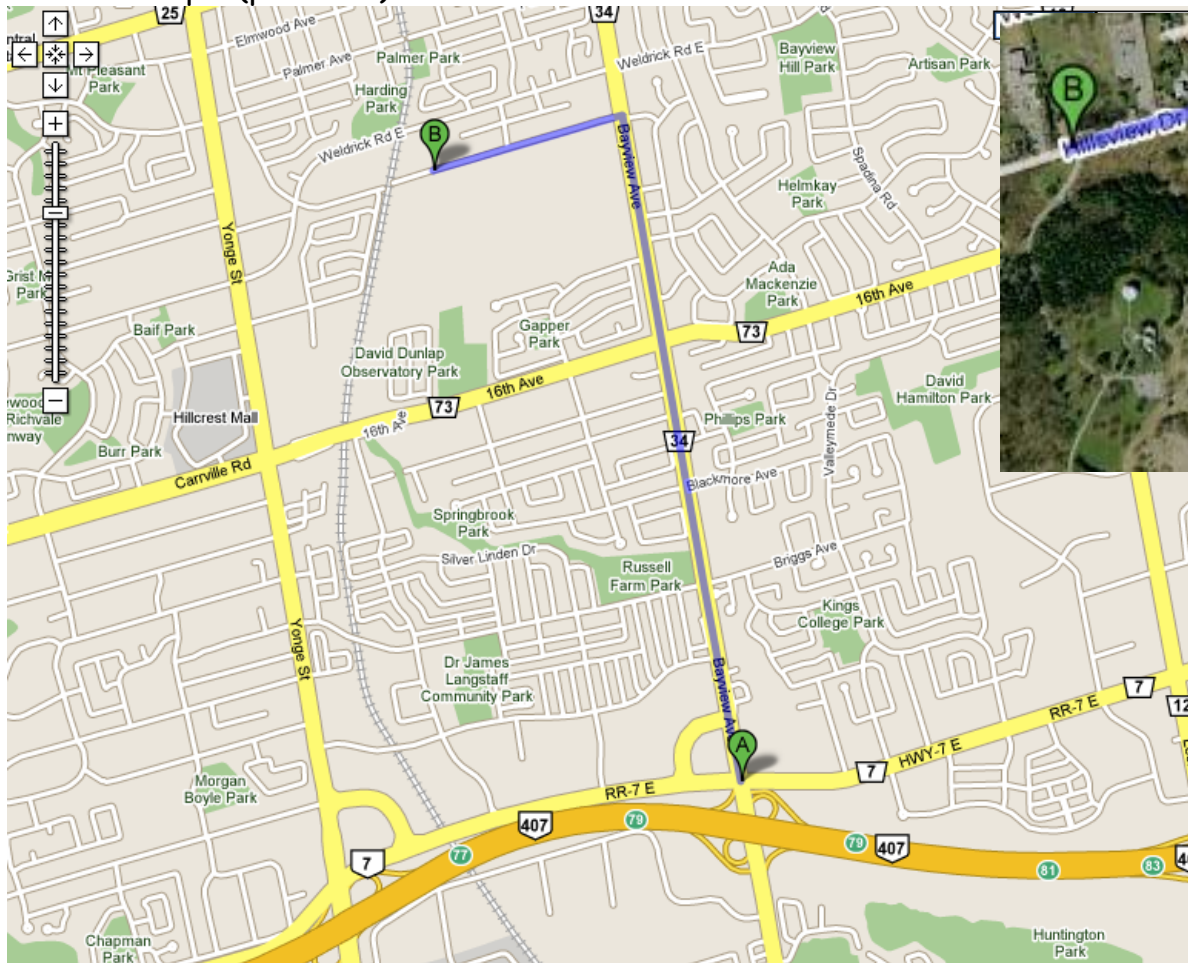
Richmond Hill is about 30km from the St. Luke's United Church and can be reached via any of the following:

- From the south by the 401 & Bayview
- From the east by the 401 - 404 & 16th Avenue
- From the west by highway 7 or 407

The observatory is located in Richmond Hill off Bayview Avenue on Hillsview Dr about 3km north of highway 7 and south of Major Mackenzie (Note Hillsview cannot be reached from Yonge St. on the west).

We meet near the entrance grounds keepers and will be let in to the parking lot around 7:00pm (point "B").



The large white dot in the satellite photo is the dome of the observatory. The administration building is to the south-east by the circular walk and the main parking lot is to south.
